## HOW TO APPLY TO GLOBAL UCF

## APPLICATION PROCESS AND POLICIES

 Applicants may complete their application online at globalucf.com, or fill out the application at the back of this brochure and scan and email it to admissions@globalucf.com, or mail it directly to:

- Official academic transcripts must be submitted by mail or in-person upon arrival on campus. Students cannot enroll until originals have been received.
- If providing originals to Global UCF upon arrival, original transcripts must be viewed by an official Global UCF recruiter, public notary or regional office and certified with a stamp on the application. Once certified, these can be scanned and emailed to admissions@globalucf.com.
- All applicants whose native language is not English must submit proof of English language ability.
- If eligible, applicants will receive a conditional offer letter specifying any outstanding documents or credentials that need to be submitted to complete the application. In addition to academic and language credentials, U.S. immigration law requires all students to provide a Certification of Finances and accompanying documentation from the applicant's bank.

- To formally accept an offer, the student must satisfy all outstanding conditions, sign the acceptance of offer and submit a \$1,000 USD deposit.
- Deposits are refundable if the student is unable to meet visa entry requirements.
- Once admitted to a program, Global UCF will send documentation to apply for visa processing with the U.S. embassy in your country.

#### HOUSING

Students enrolled in the GAA will be provided on-campus housing at an additional cost. Students will receive further information upon acceptance in the GAA.

Students directly admitted to UCF's undergraduate programs may connect with UCF's Housing and Residence Life Office at housing.ucf.edu and will receive further information upon acceptance to UCF.
